Whilst legally no student can be excluded if his or her parent does not make this contribution, if insufficient voluntary contributions are received, the activity will not take place.

The maximum number of places available on the trip is 40. If you wish your son/ daughter to take part, please arrange to make a **non-refundable deposit payment of £100.00** via your ParentPay account no later than 18 October 2019. Alternatively, if you would prefer to pay via a Paypoint account, please contact Mrs A Baxter on a.baxter@allsaints.york.sch.uk to request a barcode. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Unless otherwise stated, please note **all payments are non-refundable.**

Once payment has been made by either method, this will be taken as your consent to your son/ daughter's attendance on the trip and also your agreement that any photos taken on the trip may be used for display purposes within school/Newsletter to Parents/School Website unless otherwise requested.

The payment schedule for the trip will therefore be as follows:

1. Non-refundable deposit of £100.00 to be paid by 18 October 2019.
2. Further payment of £150.00 to be paid by 22 November 2019
3. Further payment of £150.00 to be paid by 20 December 2019
4. Final payment of £40.00 to be paid by 24 January 2020

Please note that in the event of a student causing damage to their room within the hotel, a further damage charge of up to £20.00 will be payable on return from the trip.

I must stress that participation in the trip is subject to good behaviour in school prior to the trip and approval by Senior Staff and Year Leaders. If your son/ daughter has to be withdrawn from the trip due to poor behaviour in school then you would be liable for any charges incurred.

In order to travel your son/ daughter's passport must have at least six months validity left at the time of travel and they must have a valid EHIC card.
