



Key Stage 4 Rewards



There are now 4 different ways in which you can gain Positive Behaviour Points at the Upper School.

1. Approach to Learning (AtL) Points

These are directly linked to the AtL grade you are given on your end of term progress record or your end of year report.

AtL mark of 4 = 16 to 20 points

AtL mark of 3 = 11 to 15 points

AtL mark of 2 = 6 to 10 Points

AtL mark of 1 = 0 to 5 points

2. Attendance Points

100% attendance = 50 Points

99% attendance = 30 Points

98% attendance = 10 Points

3. No Negative Behaviour Points

If you do not receive any Negative Behaviour Points during a term then you will receive an additional 50 Positive Behaviour Points.

4. Positive Behaviour Points

These are any extra Positive Behaviour Points that you accumulate during each term in and out of lessons.





REWARDS



End of term raffle—Vouchers of 1 X £20, 2 X £10, 2 X £5 will be given for the five "lucky" tickets to be drawn out of the raffle. 40 Positive Behaviour Points = 1 ticket in the raffle. Please note the credits for the raffle tickets is a cumulative score over the year.

Positive reward stickers will be presented on a termly basis in the following categories:

Bronze = 200 - Tutor time & Email
Silver = 250 - Tutor time & Email
Gold = 300 - Assembly & mail
Diamond = 350 - Assembly & Email
Platinum = 375 - Assembly & Email

The awards are presented based on the total number of Positive Behaviour Points awarded during the particular term (Autumn, Spring, Summer).

Gold Reward Trip

Any student awarded a gold certificate or higher at the end of each term will have the opportunity to go on a half day trip. (School Council to suggest ideas).

Gold Plus End of Year Reward Trip

For any student who achieves every Gold Reward during an academic year.

The Right to Study Leave - For any student who achieves 200 or more credits per term and also has an AtL average equal to or more than 2.3.
