



Attendance
Raffle drawn every 4 weeks for pupils with 100% attendance.

SLT breakfast
for the Form with the highest Attendance and also for all 100% attenders for the year

ATL Plus Reward
End of Year Full Day Trip
For any pupil who is eligible for every termly Reward Trip in the academic year

ATL Reward
Termly 1/2 Day Trip
For any pupil who has at the agreed cut off date achieved:-
ATL average of ≥ 3 and a progress average of ≥ 3
Recorded a $\geq 97\%$ attendance
(Exceptions considered at discretion of Learning Leader)
and received no sanction higher than an S2

BFL Assembly - Termly
Home clothes day for the Form scoring the highest number of Positive Behaviour Points per term.
End of term prize raffle.

Award Stickers
Diamond (250) - Presented in assembly + email
Platinum (200) - Presented in assembly + email
Gold (150) - Presented in assembly + email
Silver (100) - Presented in Tutor time + email
Bronze (50) - Presented in Tutor time + email

Positive Behaviour Points
A running total throughout the year
