Dear Parent/Carer

I hope that you have had a good Christmas with your children and that you have all managed to have some time to relax.

Following the Government announcement on Wednesday 30 December, it is important that I update you on how these changes will affect your son/daughter.

- All students will now begin remote learning on Tuesday 5 January. In a change to the Government position on 17 December, students in Year 11 and Year 13 will initially engage in remote learning along with all other year groups.
- Year 11 and Year 13 students will begin face to face learning on Monday 11 January, all other year groups will continue to be taught remotely.
- Parents/Carers have already been contacted to identify children who are classed as vulnerable or students with two key worker parents/carers. These young people are expected to attend school as normal, however, they will also engage in the same style of learning as their peers who are learning at home.
- At the time of writing this letter, all year groups are expected to be back in school for face to face teaching on Monday 18 January. We will provide updates if we receive further information from the Department for Education.

It is our intention that lessons will run as outlined in my previous communication and students are expected to follow their normal timetable and a normal school day. Should there be any technical issues using zoom, work will be posted on google classroom.

As a result of the changes to the reopening of schools, we will need to review or events calendar. Information regarding any changes will be sent out next week.


