

# **EXPECTATIONS IN CLASS & AROUND SCHOOL**

**The one rule for all members of the school community is that everyone will act with courtesy and consideration to others at all times.**

As Christians we have a duty to set a good example at all times for others to follow and not to imitate any bad examples of poor behaviour we see around us. All behaviour must be based on consideration for other people. These rules, therefore, are not designed to make life difficult, or to curtail your freedom, but to help ensure the safety and convenience of all members of the school, and the people who live in the neighbourhood.

## **Expectations for Lessons**

1. Arrive on time, fully equipped, in correct uniform and ready to start the lesson in silence.
2. Take your planner to every lesson and have it opened on the desk in front of you at the start of the lesson.
3. Follow instructions the first time they are given and do as you are told first time, every time.
4. Speak and act towards others with both courtesy and respect.
5. Do not distract others – allow teachers to teach and others to learn.

## **Expectations around school**

1. Wear full and correct uniform in class and when moving between lessons.
2. Avoid confrontation; do as you are told first time, every time.
3. Move calmly and quietly about the school keeping to the left (no running or shouting).
4. Be polite, use inoffensive language and respect the feelings of others.
5. Eat only in designated areas and place litter in the bins provided.
