Dear Parent/Carer

I would like to offer the opportunity for Year 12 Fashion & Textiles students to attend a visit to York Castle Museum on Thursday 14 July, to look at the **HERSTORY.YORK** - 100 Women Changemakers, which celebrates 100 inspirational women who, from 1918 to 2018, have made a difference to the City of York, as well as the Shaping the Body and the Sixties exhibitions.

The purpose of the trip is to gain primary research for non-exam assessment (NEA) and controlled assessment tasks. Students can take photographs and make notes and sketches as first-hand information to inspire their development work. The trip will also be useful for exam theory as questions often relate to the history of textile products. We will meet in the Textiles Room at Upper School and leave at 9.00am to walk down to the Castle Museum.

Under the terms of the Education Reform Act 1988, the school is now allowed to make a charge for this activity, but we are permitted to ask for voluntary contributions and the Governors have authorised me to do so. May I ask you therefore if you would be willing to make a voluntary contribution of £11.65 which is the cost of entrance to the Museum. Whilst legally no student can be excluded if his or her parent does not make this contribution, if insufficient voluntary contributions are received the visit may not take place.

If you wish your son/ daughter to take part, please arrange to make a non-refundable payment of £11.65 via your ParentPay account, no later than Friday 8 July (tickets are more expensive if not pre-booked). Alternatively, if you would prefer to pay via a Paypoint account, please contact Mrs A Baxter on [a.baxter@allsaints.york.sch.uk](mailto:a.baxter@allsaints.york.sch.uk) to request a barcode.

Unless otherwise stated, please note that **all payments are non-refundable.**

Once payment has been made by either method, this will be taken as consent to your son/ daughter's attendance at the visit and also your agreement that any photos taken may be used for display purposes within school, the Newsletter to Parents and or the school Website unless otherwise requested.
